- >> Male Snowboard-cross Female Snowboard-cross (inter-school title discipline)
- >> Male Halfpipe Snowboard Female Halfpipe Snowboard

Each school is permitted to enter a maximum of 4 teams (16 competitors) with a maximum of TWO teams in any single division. The minimum school team size is 3 competitors. Entry fee is \$25 per competitor and \$25 for a competition lift pass. Entries close midday on Friday 31st July and late entries may not be accepted.

2010 OTAGO SOUTHLAND INTERSECONDARY SCHOOL CHAMPS

EVENT DESCRIPTION

The Otago Southland Secondary Schools Champs is an inter-schools team competition for secondary schools located in the Otago and Southland regions.

The OSSSC includes 3 Ski (GS, SX & HP) and 2 snowboard (HP & SBX) disciplines. Each school is eligible to enter a boys, girls or mixed gender team of snowboarders and skiers. Each schools "team entry" must include a minimum of 3 competitors. Only the Ski GS and Snowboard-cross count for the NZSSSC NZ Schools Team's Titles

EVENT DISCIPLINES

- SKI GIANT SLALOM (2 timed runs)
- HALFPIPE JAM (Skiers & Snowboarders, optional discipline, jam format)
- GRAVITY CROSS time trials and elimination (Ski and Snowboard)

ENTRY ELIGIBILITY

Students must be under the age of 19 years as at 1 January 2010 and fulfil the eligibility criteria for competition in secondary school sport as defined by the NZSSS Council. Students in years 7 & 8 are NOT eligible to participate.

ENTRY DIVISIONS & TEAMS

A team must include a minimum of 3 competitors who enter either skiing or snowboarding. Each school is permitted to enter a maximum of 4 teams (16 competitors) with a maximum of TWO teams in any single division (listed below). Team changes must be received 3 days prior to the event. Late notification must be forwarded to: entry.events@cardrona.com

Mixed teams must include 1 - 2 boys or 1 - 2 girls in either skiing or snowboarding. If a school is unable to enter a full team (3 – 4 competitors) then two individual entries may be made in single division. A school with 2 individuals is not eligible for a teams result.

ENTRY FEES: The entry fee is \$25 per competitor and \$25 for a competition lift pass. ***Entries close midday on Saturday 31st July*** and late entries may not be accepted. The total team entry fee must be paid by cheque or credit card along with the entry form. The entry form must be completed in full, faxed and sent by post or email to:

REGISTRATION & BIB ALLOCATION

Lift tickets and competitor bibs will be pre assigned to competitors and must be collected by the team manager by 8:30 am on the competition day. A start list with bib numbers will also be forwarded to all team managers prior to the event. Competitor bibs must be returned after the completion of the event. Schools will be charged \$10.00 per bib not returned.

Cardrona Staff will host the event and provide all operational staff however **each school must provide at least one adult to assist** in the following roles: course marshal, bib allocation, pre starter, heat collators. *Cardrona is NOT responsible for the awards presentation. Volunteers are encouraged to contact the event secretary (Laura Hedley) via e-mail: entry.events@cardrona.com and can be sent a document on volunteer event roles & responsibilities.

Note: Volunteers must sign a volunteer's waiver when collecting bibs and prior to meeting at the top of the course. Volunteers will also be issued with high visibility vest, pencil, note pad, event schedule and competition start list.

EVENT FORMAT

Ski Giant Slalom (GS): The event will include a Giant Slalom race for skiers only on the race course trail. Competitors will race in a red, then blue course. Times from the 2 courses will be combined to determine the result. Missing a gate and failing to finish the course will result in a disqualification.

Gravity-cross (GSX): Gravity-cross involves both ski-cross (SX) and snowboard-cross racing (SBX). Competitors first complete a time trial run through the course which ranks each competitor's time. From this qualification (time trial) round only the top 16 ski and top 16 snowboarders advance to the elimination round. The elimination round is a knock out format and only 1st and 2nd place from each heat will advance towards the finals.

Halfpipe Jam (HP): A judged Halfpipe Jam will be hosted for snowboarders & skiers. Entry for this discipline is optional and does not provide results or points for the inter-schools team's title. Practice for the ski and snowboard "Halfpipe Jam" will start at 10am. The Judged Jam will run from 11:30am until 1:30pm. During the Jam competitors can continue to practice riding through the pipe and will not be judged. To receive a score skiers or snowboarders nominate a judged run by informing the start marshal that they are "dropping in" and would like their run judged. A competitor can only have 2 judged runs. The best single score will determine the result. Halfpipe is judged on variety (of tricks), difficulty and execution.
