### FORMAT AND RULES

A) Grades will be as follows:

- B) **All teams are to have available at least two nominated referees.**
- C) For the Senior Mixed Grade, teams must have 2 girls on the field at all times.
- D) All teams must wear a team uniform or if this is not possible then at the very minimum the team must wear their school PE uniform. **Shoes must be worn. Boots can ONLY be moulded soles - NO studs.**
- E) All teams **must** be supervised by an adult.
- F) Referees will be required to collect the scorecard five minutes prior to the game.

- G) Competition points will be awarded as follows: 3 – win, 2 - draw, 1 - loss, 0 – default.
- H) Games will start at 4.00pm each Tuesday at Bishopscourt

**Rules:** Standard New Zealand touch rules. **Note:** A team may consist of up to 14 players. A maximum of six (6) are allowed on the field at any one time. A minimum of four players are required for the match to be played.

**Defaults:** First contact your opposition then contact Geoff Rodden or Des Smith on 470 1337 or 021 736116.

The defaulting school must advise their opposition (and the OSSSA office) of the default by 12 noon on the day of the match. Failure to follow these guidelines will result in a default fee of **\$20 per match** being recorded against the defaulting team.

#### **Referees:**

Each team must have **2 referees** available each week to do duty. Duty will be shared out during the season.

If your referees do not turn up to officiate at their allocated game(s) you will be fined **\$20 per match**.

#### **Meeting:**

There will be a **COMPULSORY** meeting for all schools who have entered. This will be held on Thursday 11 February at 4pm at John McGlashan College.
