# **Seniors Proposal Monday Nights Premier Grade**

**Philosophy:** To provide quality games for players and coaches attending the South Island and National volleyball tournament

## **Girl's Premier Grade**

### **Entry:**

Will be limited to the teams going to the Mainland tournament or higher. Teams will be ranked based on the results from the previous years Otago tournament. If a school/team did not participate the previous year it takes the lowest placed ranking in order of entry.

### **Format**

**Teams will be put into groups of 3 for each Monday night. Teams play 2 games of 3 sets up to 25 each night plus do one duty. The next week teams are regrouped so you play new teams.**

**A results table will be kept and results will be posted on the VO website. Each set won scores a league point.**

The team with the highest league points will be seeded first for the Otago tournament, and so on down. If teams have the same number of league points then placing will be decided on the basis of the ratio of points for and against.

### **Rules**

Teams must be in uniforms with numbers on front and back that meet the requirement for the Mainland tournament.

### **Duty**

- This will consist of a referee and 2<sup>nd</sup> referee that has sat and passed the regional "A" referee's course.
- 4 Lines people
- A proper score sheet that records players positions and rotations must be used and must be completed properly

Teams that fail to complete the duty adequately will get a league point deducted. Teams that regularly fail to fulfil these requirements will be placed in the B grade

# Boy's Premier Grade

## **Entry:**

Will be limited to the teams going to the Mainland tournament or higher, plus any men's team's that want to play.

Teams will be ranked based on the results from the previous years Otago tournament. If a school/team did not participate the previous year it takes the lowest placed ranking in order of entry.

## **Format**

Teams will be put into groups of 3 for each Monday night. Teams play 2 games of 3 sets up to 25 each night plus do one duty. The next week teams are regrouped so you play new teams.

A results table will be kept and results will be posted on the VO website.

Each set won scores a league point.

The team with the highest league points will be seeded first for the Otago tournament, and so on down. If teams have the same number of league points then placing will be decided on the basis of the ratio of points for and against.
